1119	Runway Number	A runway identifier consists of a two-digit number and on parallel runways is supplemented by a letter. On a single runway, dual parallel runways and triple parallel runways the two-digit number shall be the whole number nearest the one-tenth of the magnetic North when viewed from the direction of approach. On four or more parallel runways, one set of adjacent runways shall be numbered to the nearest one tenth magnetic azimuth and the other set of adjacent runways to the next nearest one-tenth magnetic azimuth. When the above rule results in a single digit number it is preceded by a zero. In the case of parallel runways, each runway designation number is supplemented by a letter as follows, in the order shown from left to right when viewed from the direction of approach: For two parallel runways: "L" "R"; for three parallel runways: "L" "C" "R"; for four parallel runways: "L" "R" "L" "R"; for five parallel runways: "L" "C" "R" "L" "R"; or "L" "R" "L" "C" "R" and for six parallel runways: "L" "C" "R" "L" "C" "R".
